- Students should present content on their poster in Flash Talk session (please refer to tentative of seminar). Flash Talk can be in English or Malay. During Flash Talk, students might present your research effectively in 5 minutes and students allowed ONE POWERPOINT SLIDE.
- Poster evaluation is based on judges' opinion
