

## DEPARTMENT OF CHEMICAL ENGINEERING

### EVENT NAME : Chem Quiz

- Team Structure: Maximum of 5 members per team.
- Rounds: There are 3 rounds in total.

#### Round 1:

- Type: General knowledge questions based on Chemical Engineering and General Science.
- Time Limit: 30 seconds per question.
- Selection: Only shortlisted teams will proceed to the next round.

#### Round 2:

- Type: Identify chemical processes, equipment, or elements from a given picture.
- Time Limit: 40 seconds per question.
- Selection: Only shortlisted teams will proceed to the next round.

#### Round 3:

- Type: CHEM Puzzle.
- Task: Find as many chemical-related words as possible from a given puzzle.
- Time Limit: 5 minutes.
- Final Result: Based on cumulative marks from all rounds.

### EVENT NAME: Charlie

- Team Structure: 3 members per team. Teams can be mixed with students from different colleges.
- Rounds: There are 3 rounds.

#### Round 1: Blindfold

- Two team members are blindfolded, while one member is not.
- The non-blindfolded member must guide the blindfolded ones to collect balls using gestures (no verbal communication).
- Task: Collect the maximum number of balls within 1 minute to move to the next round.

#### Round 2: Don't Drop the Ball

- Each member is given a paper straw.
- Task: Use the straw to lift a sponge ball and carry it to a specified distance without dropping it.
- Task Duration: 1 minute.
- Teams with the most balls carried successfully proceed to the next round.

#### Round 3: Dumb Charades

- One volunteer from the team acts out the name of a chemical compound or process without speaking.
- The other two team members must guess the correct answer.
- Time Limit: 2 minutes.
- The team with the most correct guesses wins.

### EVENT NAME: Mary Blast

- Rounds: There are 3 rounds.

#### Round 1: Fun with Chemicals

- Task: One team member draws chemical processes, symbols, or lab equipment, and the teammates must guess the correct term.

#### Round 2: Blind Taste Test

- Task: Participants are blindfolded and given small portions of various foods (e.g., fruits, chips, sauces).
- Objective: Guess the food item based on taste alone.

#### Round 3: Guess the Song

- Task: Play 5-10 second clips of popular songs.
- Objective: Teams write down their guesses for each song.
- Winner: The team with the most correct guesses wins.
