WEB PAGE DESIGNING RULES:

1. A maximum of two participants is allowed per team.
2. Systems will be provided in the lab.
3. The theme will be given on the spot.
4. Time duration: 60 minutes for designing the website using HTML, CSS, and JavaScript.
5. Clearly define your website's purpose—it should make visitors' lives easier, not more complicated.
6. Once you have a clear sense of how your site should be laid out, you can start coding.
7. Save your progress as you code/design.
8. Use strong visuals like images and graphics. Your website's images need to capture users' attention, embrace complementary colors, and create a lasting impression.
9. Ensure your website functions well.

CODE BATTLE EVENT RULES

Event Overview:

The Code Battle is a competitive coding challenge where participants will solve programming problems using C++ and Java. Winners will be determined based on the number of problems solved correctly.

Eligibility:

Open to all students and professionals with programming skills. Participants must compete individually..

Programming Languages:

Allowed languages: C++ and Java.

Competition Structure:

The event consists of multiple rounds, each featuring a set of programming problems. Winners will be announced based on the number of problems solved correctly.

Disqualification:

Participants will be disqualified for:

- Using unauthorized resources or outside help.
- Tampering with the platform or interfering with other participants' performance.
- Any misconduct or violation of event rules.

Technical Requirements:

All participants must bring their own laptops.

TECHNICAL STRAT UP IDEAS EVENT RULES

1. Each team must consist of 2 members.
2. Teams must select a category and develop an idea within that category.
3. Teams must prepare a 5-minute pitch presentation.
4. Teams must answer questions from the judges during the presentation.
5. Only one presentation round will be held.

Pitching Rules:

Time Limit: Each team typically gets 5-10 minutes for the presentation.

Language: The presentation should only be in English.
