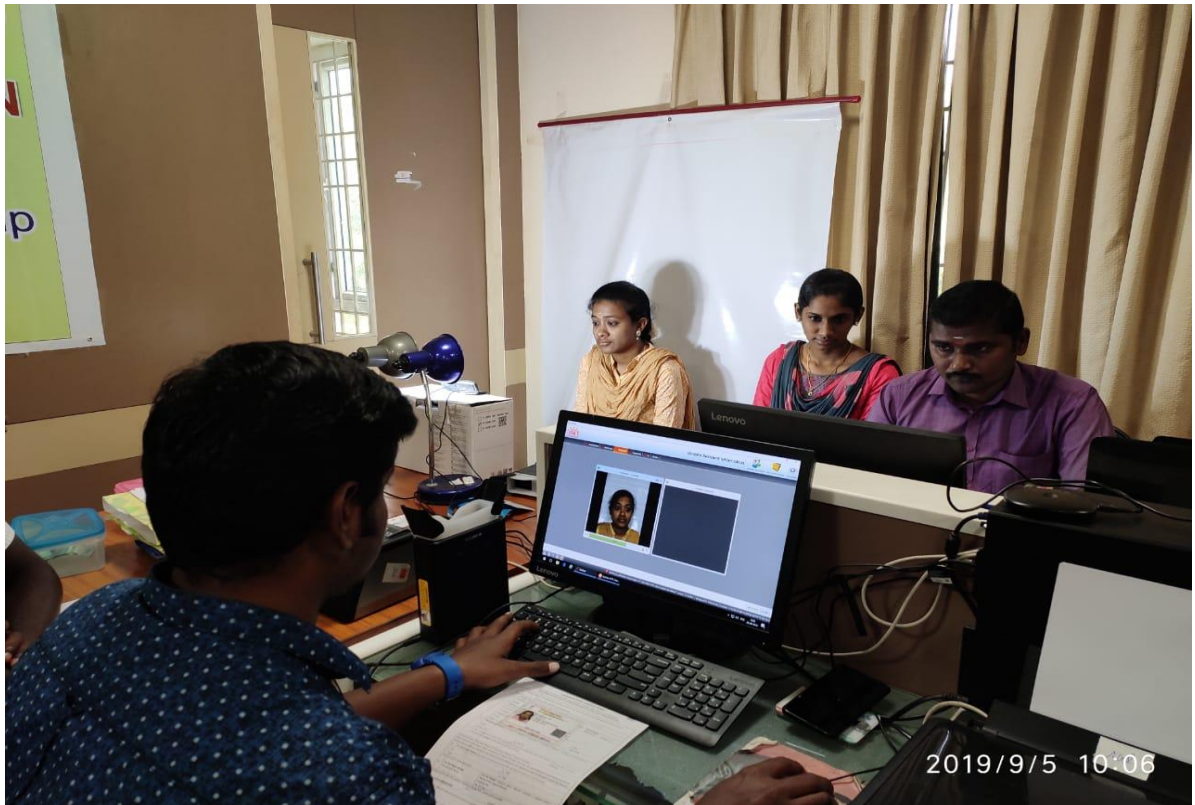
Activity Name: AADHAAR ENROLLMENT & UPDATION SPECIAL CAMP

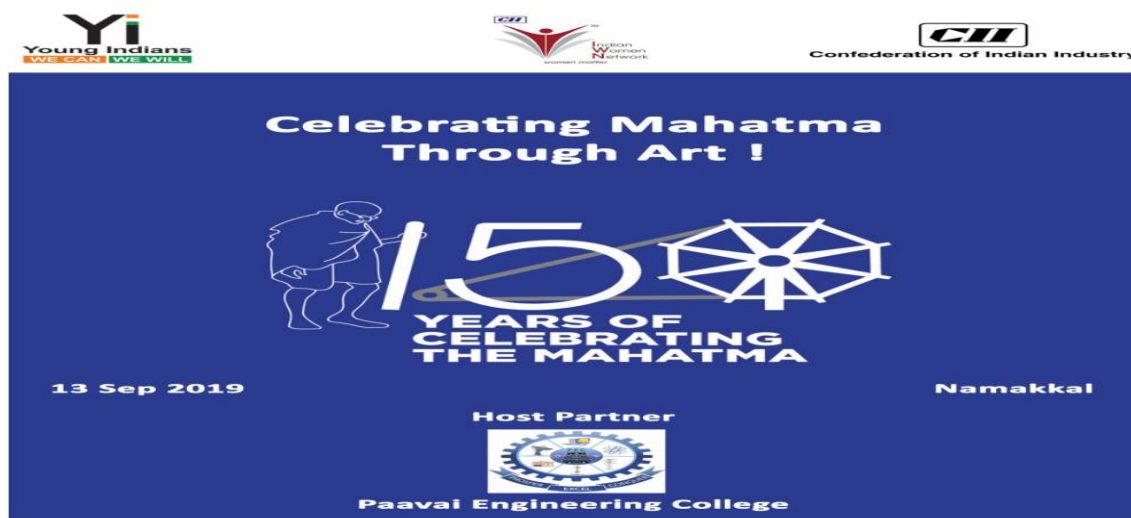
Activity Name: 150th Birthday Celebration of Mahatma Gandhi
