Paavai Engineering College has secured all India rank I from AICTE along with Internshala consecutively for four years for the highest internship record all over India. Our institution is recognized as a top performer and is one of the top 50 premiere institutes in India in the under-ranking of institutions for innovation achievements for two consecutive years, 2021 and 2022. Paavai has been awarded as one of the top three innovative institutes by the Confederation of Indian Industry for two successive years, 2021 and 2022.

Our students in the 2022 batch have received 2000+ offers through campus recruitment from Infosys, TCS, IBM, Accenture, L&T, and Cognizant, and 93 reputed companies have visited and given 2085 offer letters to the current final year students.

Paavai Engineering College was awarded as the best engineering college by the News8 TV channel in Tamil Nadu for its excellence in offering quality technical education to rural students, which was held in Coimbatore on October 29, 2022. Our institute has been awarded platinum status by AICTE CII for six consecutive years. The institutional innovation council of our college organized various activities on innovation and startups that earned it four-star status, which is the highest status granted by AICTE, the Ministry of Education, and the Government of India.

Our institution has the 5<sup>th</sup> position in Tamil Nadu Engineering Admission for the academic year 2022–23, and we have been in the top 10 position consecutively for the past four years. We have signed a memorandum of understanding with 63 leading organizations in India and abroad.
