- Plastic coated plates
- Plastic coated paper cups, Plastic tea cups, Plastic tumbler, Thermocoal cups
- Plastic carry bag of all sizes and thickness, Plastic coated carry bags, non-woven bags
- Water pouches / Packets / Bottles

POLICY SCOPE

The policy will be applicable for all the teaching staff, non – teaching staff, security, students and their parents or guardians.

PROCEDURES

- To communicate the policy objectives and action plan to staffs and students.
- To organize/ conduct awareness programmes on environmental pollution due to plastics
- To conduct rally/campaign on, "No plastic" in the campus and surroundings
- To create the awareness of soil degradation and water contamination due to the disposal of plastic carry bags.
- To clarify and define the plastics that has to be avoided inside or outside the campus (Carry bags), instead use paper bags, cloth bags and jute bags.
- To encourage the use of steel or copper water bottles rather than plastic.
- To adhere the, "No Plastic Zone" in the campus.
