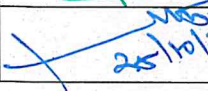
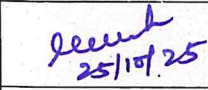

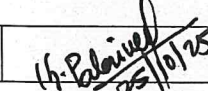
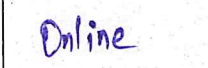
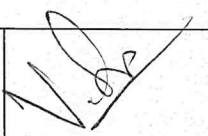
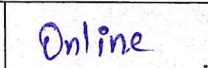
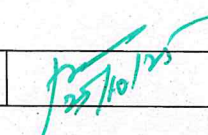
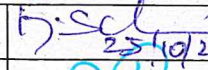

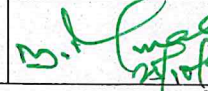
- Appreciations were given by all the members of the Governing Council for the tremendous efforts in various areas:

 - Students and faculties should be encouraged to apply for the PM Yashasvi Scheme.

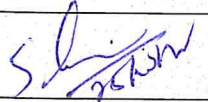
