2. Appreciated the initiatives taken to establish foreign collaborations with universities in Taiwan, Malaysia, Italy, South Korea, the U.S.A., and others, enabling student internships, research projects, and collaborative academic and research activities.

Recommendations

The University Nominee, the State Government Nominee and the External Experts of Governing Council have provided the following recommendations for implementation:

1. Students should be encouraged to appear for the GATE examination starting from their third year.
2. A greater number of National and International Conferences should be organized annually, aligned with relevant Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs).
3. Faculty members should undertake edited books in emerging areas to strengthen and support the curriculum.
4. On the occasion of Paavai Engineering College's 25th year, a "Distinguished Alumni Award" may be instituted to honor outstanding alumni.
5. Faculty awards and recognition schemes should be implemented, including seed grants to support faculty research and innovation.
6. A strategic plan for the next 25 years should be developed, approved and implemented.
7. The current three-hour internal test may be reduced to one and a half hours for 50 marks, to ease students' academic workload.
8. Financial and academic incentives may be provided to support economically disadvantaged students.










9. PIF course certifications should be aligned with academic subjects and included in the basket of activities for formative assessments.
10. For formative assessments, a structured basket of activities should be planned. Rubrics for these assessments should be formulated by a departmental committee comprising the HoD, senior faculty members, and subject faculty.
11. The students may be given training in 5G related technologies with the support of Ericsson kits dealt by the organization called Nanocell Networks who has the specialization in 5G, 6G and Wi-Fi technologies training
12. Transcend satellite technology is helping to launch mini and micro satellites and Paavai can rope in this organization for satellite launching since we already have ground station for ISRO Balloon launching project
13. University nominee insisted that the academic and research activities should be as per the norms of Anna University.
